



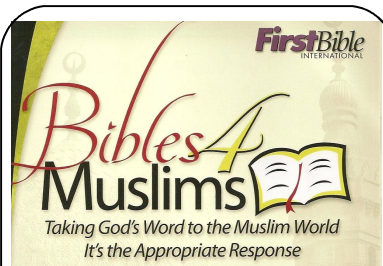
Welcome Sisters!

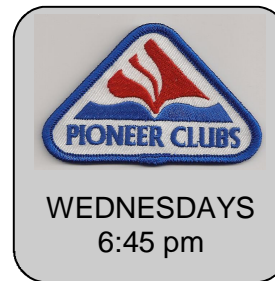
