Born February 24, 1982, in Charleston, West Virginia, Evangelist C.T. Townsend was brought up in a Pastor's home and raised around the church house and it's Christian School. Townsend graduated from Fair Haven Christian

School in 2000. He then received continuing education at Pensacola Christian College, in Pensacola, Florida, and West Virginia State College right outside of Charleston, WV.

In January of 2003, God called Bro. Townsend to preach the gospel. Months later he enrolled at Victory Baptist College, in North Augusta, South Carolina.
